

# 13,000 BJP booth heads to interact with Amit Shah Sunday



New Delhi 19 December: Over 13,000 BJP booth presidents will interact with party president Amit Shah at IGI Stadium Sunday. "The interaction will be followed by a question-answer session during which some will be given an opportunity to ask the party president about his election management formula in the run-up to the 2019 Lok Sabha polls," head of booth management department of the Delhi BJP, Dharambir Singh, said. He said that 13,816 booth presidents and senior leaders, including ward councillors, MLAs, MPs, party president and others will attend the event. This will include Manoj Tiwari. Booth incharges are being issued barcode-based identity cards to ensure they attend the event, he said. There are a total of 13,816 polling booths across Delhi, and so far over 12,000 booth incharges have been appointed.

## Government body chief pitches for Nitin Gadkari as PM



New Delhi 19 December: Kishore Tiwari, who heads the government-appointed Vasantrao Naik Sheti Swavalamban Mission and holds MoS rank, has urged the RSS to replace Prime Minister Narendra Modi with Union Minister and Nagpur MP Nitin Gadkari "if the BJP wishes to win the 2019 Lok Sabha elections". He has made the demand in a letter to RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat. In a press note, Tiwari said, "After the party's recent electoral debacle, animated discussions have ensued within and outside the BJP regarding the extreme unipolar (ekchhatri) and dictatorial (hukumshahi) conduct of the party's central leadership.

# Man accidentally shoots at friend while showing gun



Thane 19 December: A 20-year-old man was injured when his friend accidentally shot at him from a country-made revolver here in Maharashtra, police said Wednesday. A group of friends was chatting on a roadside at Kisan Nagar locality in Wagle Estate area on Tuesday night when one of them took out his revolver to show it to them, senior police inspector S M Patil said. While the man was showing the gun, he allegedly pulled the trigger accidentally and shot his friend Vijay Yadav in the stomach, the official said. Yadav was immediately rushed to a private hospital where he was undergoing treatment, Patil said. One person, whose identity was not revealed, was arrested and was booked under IPC section 338 (causing grievous hurt by act endangering life or personal safety of others) and provisions of the Maharashtra Police Act. A probe was on into the incident and the police were also trying to ascertain how the man got the weapon and whether he had a valid licence for it, the official said.

Kolkata 19 December: The CID on Monday filed a chargesheet against 72 people in connection with the June 8 clash between Gorkha Janmukti Morcha (GJM) supporters and police in Darjeeling, which had led to a 104-day shutdown in the Hills. Among those named in the chargesheet are wanted GJM faction leader Bimal Gurung, his wife Asha,

Roshan Giri and others. "72 people have been named in the chargesheet submitted yesterday," confirmed a CID officer, adding that 45 persons named in the chargesheet are still absconding. The accused were booked under IPC sections including 307 (attempt to murder),147-149 (rioting with arms and unlawful assembly), 153-153A (promoting enmity between different groups),

323-326 (voluntarily causing grievous hurt), 332-353 (assault or criminal force to deter public servant), 436 (mischief by fire and explosive substance), 506 (criminal intimidation) and 120B (criminal conspiracy). Sections of the West Bengal Maintenance of Public Order Act (WBMPO) and Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act (PDPP) were also invoked.

## Manohar Lal Khattar in Surat, says Rahul 'lies like Goebbels'



Surat 19 December: Haryana Chief Minister and BJP leader Manohar Lal Khattar on Tuesday compared Rahul Gandhi with Hitler's information minister, Paul Joesph Goebbels, saying that the Congress president is adhering to the principal that if a lie is spoken for hundred times it will look like truth. Khattar, who was in Surat as part of the BJP campaign to hit out against the Congress over the multi-billion dollar Rafale jet deal following the Supreme Court quashing the petitions seeking CBI probe into the purchase of 36 fighter aircraft, said, "Now if a lie is spoken for hundred times or thousand times it will remain lie and it will not be truth.

# Research, not subsidy, will make e-vehicles affordable

Surat 19 December: Electric vehicles will have to be affordable in order to be popular, Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal said Tuesday, stressing that subsidising them would not be



feasible in the long run. Addressing a Delhi Dialogue and Development Commission workshop on the draft e-vehicle policy of the Delhi government, Kejriwal called upon industry leaders to invest more on research and development of electric vehicles to reduce their market prices. Incidentally, the draft policy also lays major emphasis on subsidising e-vehicles — ranging from two-wheelers to four-wheelers — for Delhi to have 25 per cent of all vehicle registrations of e-vehicles by 2023.

### WCD ministry ropes in Magsaysay winner to help trace families of women inmates at mental hospitals

Pune 19 December: Union Minister of Women and Child Development Maneka Gandhi has authorised Magsaysay award winner Bharat Vatwani to assess the condition of destitute women inmates at government-run mental hospitals in the country and help trace their families so that they can be reunited. In an official letter issued on December 12, the Union minister said that involving Vatwani



and his social workers from the Shraddha Rehabilitation Foundation will pave the way for rehabil-

itation of the wandering mentally ill women destitutes, presently sheltered at government mental

institutions. Vatwani, winner of the Ramon Magsaysay Award, has helped reunite 7,000 mentally ill people with their families across the country and even in Nepal. "Since we set up the Shraddha Rehabilitation Foundation in 2006-07, a total of 5,700 mentally ill persons have been rehabilitated and, of these, 683 have been referrals from government mental hospitals and shelter homes. "We have

been able to unite at least 166 mentally ill people from Ahmedabad Mental Hospital with their families, 193 from Bhuj Mental Hospital, 227 from the Institute of Mental Health, Chennai, 89 from Vadodara Mental Hospital, four from Mahila Ashram at Karjat and one each from Alibaug Civil Hospital, Mahila Vasti Gruh, Chembur, **Bareily Mental Hospital** and Beggar Home, Chembur," Vatwani said.

### 118 teaser: Kalyan Ram promises an engaging thriller



New Delhi : Shah Rukh Khan as vertically challenged Bauua Singh in Zero is all set to win hearts at the theaters. In an exclusive conversation with indianexpress.com, the 53-year-old actor says Zero is a film made with an idea of treating people as equals. When Aanand and Himanshu were narrating the story, the first thing they told me before the narration was that 'Khan saab, what we want to do is take away from you all that you are known for and put you in a position, similarly for the other actors.' For instance, Katrina is imposingly known for being a diva or doing dance numbers which are sizzling etc. Similarly, for Anushka, she is a very mer-



curial actor, I find her like that honestly. You go to that actor and say I am going to make you sit in a wheelchair dealing with a syndrome, but you would still be a heroine and object of romance. So, I think that was very interest-

ing. What Aanand wanted was something contrary to what we stand for but still fit into the parameters of a commercial, family film that has all the ingredients. Also, one thing he was very clear about was that he did not

want any of us to search, ask or beg for empathy. (He said) Just let your incompleteness be celebrated. You should not look sad. The whole idea of equality is that you look at any of us, you should treat them as equals.

That is a message the film sends. For me, it was a little easier because technology helped me a lot. The VFX team gave me the freedom to be how I am, except for a few technical things. For Anushka, she underwent a whole process of understanding cerebral palsy. It is a commercial film but when you are dealing with an affliction like this, you have to be true to it, but still maintain what you would like a commercial actress to do.
